## About the Course

## Background

The year 2023 marks the 8th anniversary of two very important environmental milestones: the Sustainable Goals (SDG's) and the Paris Climate Agreement. Both ambitious multilateral initiatives marked the roadmap for the global sustainability agenda, aiming to bring about peace and prosperity for people and our home, planet Earth. Despite international advances, more efforts are needed to mitigate climate change and its disastrous effects. Furthermore, such efforts must be of multidisciplinary nature, integrating aspects of gender equality, community development and green innovation and tech. In recent years, the OECD has conducted a number of studies linking the gender-environment nexus, detailing how the efforts against climate change should go together with those promoting gender equality.

Israel continues to work towards the implementation of the SDG's through all sectors of society, namely, national programs, civil society organizations, and the start-up community.

MASHAV through its affiliate MCTC, facilitates the sharing of Israel's experience and participants' countries best practices regarding climate change mitigation and adaptation, the promotion of gender equality, sustainable community development, leadership development, and green innovation.

## Application requirements

The international workshop is designed for women and men community leaders, grassroots development officers, national and local government officers, non-governmental development practitioners, and women's organizations. Candidates are expected to have academic training or equivalent professional qualifications in relevant subject matter, with at least 5 years of practical experience. They should be engaged in, or aspiring to lead environmentally sustainable practices in their communities. Good command of English is required.

Participants must arrive at the training center on the arrival date, and leave on the departure date. Early arrivals/late departures if required, must be arranged by the participants themselves, directly with the center, and must be paid for by the participant him/herself.

#### Location and Accommodation

MASHAV awards a limited number of scholarships. The scholarship covers the cost of the training program including lectures and field visits, full board accommodation in double rooms (two participants per room), health insurance (see below) and transfers to and from the airport. Airfares and daily allowance are <u>not</u> included in the scholarship.

# The course will be held in Haifa. Participants will be accommodated in double rooms (two participants per room).

#### Health Services

#### About the Course

#### Background

Environmental challenges have a variety of causes with multiple effects. These effects manifest themselves locally, regionally, or globally. Dealing with these challenges is often complicated, involving many elements, such as society, locale, time scale, and multiple scientific disciplines.

Communities consist of systems, subsystems, and other components in a complex hierarchy. In this course, we will learn how "design thinking" offers a more appropriate mindset than deterministic and reductionist thinking when addressing the various stages of environmental projects. Such an approach to environmental problem-solving helps build a system- and complexity-aware approach when considering project initiating, planning, executing, monitoring, controlling, and closing. The "design" approach, including the life-cycle analysis approach, will be used in this course to show the integration and interaction of different components, and how to utilize them to design sustainable integrated solutions in local communities.

The training course will be held at the Arava Institute for Environmental Studies, located on Kibbutz Ketura in the south of Israel, and provides an opportunity for mid-level professionals from the public and private sectors to gain knowledge about integrated solutions for environmental problems. Primary topics include the principles of design thinking for environmental solutions, sustainable project planning, design, and project implementation, while introducing relevant technologies.

#### Main subjects

The training course has four main pillars:

- Design thinking
- II. Sustainability and sustainable development
- III. The Nexus concept
- IV. Integrated technological solutions


In addition to frontal lectures, site visits will convey the importance of integrated environmental solutions through field trips to factories, projects, research centers in the north of the country and the Dead Sea region. Participants will also visit several sites in the southern Arava region, including landfills, waste sorting facilities, wastewater treatment facilities, renewable energy fields, aquaponics and permaculture centers.

Participants will take part in organized tours of the holy sites and locations of general and historical interest as well. Social and cultural activities will also be arranged.

#### Aims

Course participants will learn to:

- Promote participatory decision-making;
- Develop community needs assessments;
- Identify and develop appropriate tools (e.g., inventories, monitoring techniques, analysis, questionnaires etc.);
- Define various suitable technologies based on existing knowledge and need within the community (including economic parameters and priorities);
- Identify metrics for a project design, including project success vs. failure;
- Develop monitoring and evaluation procedures for a built system;
- Create transparent communication between different stakeholders.



## Application

#### Application Requirements

The course is designed for individuals who are interested in expanding their knowledge and developing initiatives regarding integrated environmental solutions, design thinking, environmental management, and sustainable community governance. It is intended for mid-level professionals working for government or non-governmental organizations, decision-making bodies, academia, and the private sector. It is also beneficial for those who are involved in community development and are directly involved in the search for practical community solutions.

The program will be conducted in English, so participants must have a high level of English reading, writing, and speaking.

Participants should have at least the equivalent of a university degree or professional diploma and a desire to leverage their knowledge in a field related to integrated environmental solutions.

Competition for the MASHAV Courses is merit-based and selection will be made on the basis of applicants' achievements, interest, added value of the program to the participant, professional aptitude, leadership potential in the field of sustainability, and knowledge of English.

Funding for the MASHAV Courses is limited and the program is highly competitive; not all qualified applicants will receive awards.

#### Application forms

Application forms and other information may be obtained at the nearest Israeli Embassy or at the MASHAV or Arava Institute websites. Completed application forms, including medical forms, should be submitted no later than July 6th, 2023 to the Israeli Embassy nearest to you.

#### General Information

MASHAV awards a limited number of scholarships. The scholarship covers the cost of the training program including lectures and site visits, full-board accommodation in double rooms (two participants per room), health insurance (see next page) and transportation to and from the airport. Airfares and daily spending allowance are <u>not</u> included in the scholarship.

Arrival and Departure

Arrival date: Sunday, August 27th, 2023 Opening date: Monday, August 28th, 2023 Closing date: Tuesday, September 12th, 2023

Departure date: Wednesday, September 13th, 2023

Participants must arrive in Israel on the arrival date, and leave on the departure date. Early arrivals/late departures (if required) must be arranged directly with the hotel/center, and must be paid for by the participant.

#### Location and Accommodation

The course will be held at the Arava Institute for Environmental Studies, situated at Kibbutz Ketura in the Arava Desert, a four-hour drive from the center of Israel. Kibbutz Ketura is a collective community, located in the Arava valley of Israel. It is approximately 50 kilometers from the Red Sea resort city of Eilat in the south of Israel. In August and September the weather will be hot; temperatures will range from around 35°-45°C during the day and get down to about 25°C at night. #### Health Services

- MASHAV'S Medical form/declaration must be completed and submitted to the Embassy of Israel together with the application form.
- 2. MASHAV'S Medical insurance covers only medical services and hospitalization in case of emergency.
